Users' rules

- **General definition of the concept “toy library”**

A toy library is a non-profit organisation.

In the same manner a library lends books, a toy library lends games and toys on easy terms.

- **What can you expect in our toy library ?**

First of all, in our toy library you can lend games and toys.

A annual membership is required in order to borrow games and toys.

Preschool children must be accompanied by an adult.

Children are under the responsibility of their parents or the person who accompanying them.

It is not allowed to eat, drink or smoke in the toy library.

Please consider, when you play in our toy library, tidy up afterwards.

- **Our range:** (We have about 2200 games and toys)

• **Who can use our toy library ?**

Everybody who likes to play is welcome in our toy library: small children, school children, teenagers, adults, families or schools.

• **How much does a loan cost ?**

The annual fee is valid from the first day of subscription

An ID must be presented for the subscription.

Loan fees are mentioned on each game.

The annual fee is CHF 30.00 for citizens of Olten and CHF 35.00 for surrounding municipalities plus loan fees.

• **How many games can we borrow?**

For the whole Family one membership card will be issued.

There is no limit to the number of games that can be borrowed.

• **For how long can we borrow the games ?**

Only one extension of 4 weeks is possible.

If we must send a reminder, we charge CHF 4.00/8.00/12.00 plus loan fees

• **Return of games / control**

Missing or broken pieces must be announced by the return of the game or toy.

The loaned games or toys must be brought back in good condition at the due date.

If a user loses or busts a game, he must pay a deposit.

• **Responsibility**

We are not liable for any direct or indirect damages or injuries with any loaned game or toy.

• **Opening hours**

Wednesday from 14.00 to 17.00

Thursday from 18.00 to 20.00

Saturday from 09.00 to 12.00

During school holidays, the toy library has reduced opening hours. Consult our website.

Members are requested to report change of address.

The toy library has the right to exclude a member who does not respect our rules.
